



With a team of volunteers we are assisting the many Tibetan refugees who escaped from their homes in Tibet after the Chinese invasion; in addition we are supporting other independent and necessary projects in the fields of: **Healthcare** - construction and renovation of hospitals, medical emergencies, maintenance of delivery rooms, support for the disabled, vaccination programmes; **Nutrition** - food integration in school canteens and for tuberculosis patients; **Education** - University and college scholarships, school building renovation, professional training; **Welfare** - support for retirement homes, maintenance of means of transport, rent payment.
